About Real Time Text - RTT



<u>**Real-time text</u></u> – or RTT lets you use text to communicate during a phone call. With RTT, there is no need to press send to get your message out. A recipient can read a message while the sender types it.</u>**

<u>RTT is currently supported on the following devices:</u>

- Sonim XP8 Software version Build Number: 8A.0.4.12-8.1.0-26.28.00
- Samsung S20FE Software version Build Number: **RP1A.200720.012.G978U1UEU4DUE1**

Notes:

- * Both send and receive devices must be RTT capable.
- * RTT is only supported on the Sonim XP8 and Samsung S20FE after upgrading at this time.
- * RTT is not supported on the Sonim XP5



About Real Time Text - RTT

Access the RTT setting from:

<u>Sonim XP8</u>

- Main Settings > Accessibility > RTT (Real Time Text)
- From the Phone Application > Menu > Settings > Accessibility

 From the Phone Dialer > Menu > Settings > Real Time Text

About Real Time Text - RTT

There are 2 settings that control when the RTT call button is displayed.

<u>Visible during calls</u> – is the default setting. This setting displays the -RTT Call button only during an active phone call.

<u>Always visible -</u> This setting displays the RTT Call option/button when initiating and when receiving a phone call. When receiving or initiating a phone call the user gets presented with 2

options:

- Voice call only
- Voice+RTT call

$oldsymbol{O}$	Visible during calls Show the RTT call button only during calls.
0	Always visible Show the RTT call button whenever you make an receive calls.



Making a RTT call with default setting – Visible during calls

<u>Sonim XP8</u>

- 1. Place the call from the phone dialer, contacts, or recent calls.
- 2. Once call is answered select Switch to RTT
- 3. At first use a message is displayed introducing the RTT feature, select **OK, GOT IT**.
- 4. Using the Real Time Text keyboard begin typing your message
- 5. To end the call, select **End** button.

Samsung S20FE

- 1. Place the call from the phone dialer, contacts or recent calls
- 2. Once the call is answered select the menu key and then select **Start RTT** call.
- 3. At first use a welcome message is displayed, select the x to dismiss.
- 4. Using the Real Time Text keyboard begin typing your message.
- 5. To end the call, select the **End** button.



Making a RTT call using the Always Visible setting:

Sonim XP8

- 1. Place the call from the phone dialer, contacts, or recent calls.
- 2. Select Voice+RTT call.
- 3. At first use a message is displayed introducing the RTT feature, select **OK, GOT IT**.
- 4. The called party will see the RTT call button to answer the call.
- 5. Once answered, use the Real Time Text keyboard to begin typing your message.
- 6. To end the phone call, select the **end** button at the top of the screen.

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Making a RTT call using the Always Visible setting:

Samsung S20FE

- 1. Place the call from the phone dialer, contacts, or recent calls.
- 2. Select the **RTT call button/icon**
- 3. The called party will see the RTT call button to answer the call.
- 4. At first use a message is displayed introducing the RTT feature, select **OK**, **GOT IT**.
- 5. Once answered, at first use a welcome message is displayed, select the "x" to dismiss.
- 6. Use the Real Time Text keyboard to begin typing your message.
- 7. To end the phone call, select the **end** button at the top of the screen.



Difference between text in progress and completed:

Completed text – Select the checkmark or Done to complete text. This text will appear in a separate bubble

Received text – Text received from the other device. This text will appear in a separate bubble and include avatar.

Text in Progress - Text that is still being typed or has not yet completed. This text will appear in the text input box as well as above it before being completed.

Sender – Visible during calls/ Receiver – Always Visible

From Locked or Sleep Mode

Sonim XP8

- Swipe Up to answer voice only
- Drag RTT symbol to answer RTT+Voice



- Samsung S20FE
- Voice only swipe right



From Home Screen

<u>Sonim XP8</u> - Select RTT or Voice



<u>Samsung S20FE</u> - Voice only Swipe Right



How does it work? Switching between RTT and Voice call

No matter how the call originated it can be switched:

- To switch (upgrade) from a voice only call to RTT+Voice
 - 1. While engaged in an active voice call select **Switch to RTT** or **Real Time Text**
 - 2. Using the Real Time Text keyboard type message
 - 3. Select the End button to end the call.
- To switch (downgrade) from a RTT+Voice Call
 - 1. While engaged in an active RTT+Voice call press the **Menu** key to access Settings
 - 2. Select Switch to Voice Call or Switch to Voice-only call





Things to Know Other functionality while engaged in a RTT call

<mark>To mute audio:</mark>

- Sonim XP8 Press the menu icon then select Mute
- Samsung S20 FE Press the Mute button in the active call Window

To listen to audio through the loudspeaker

- Sonim XP8 Press the menu key then select Speaker On
- Samsung 20FE Press the Speaker button on in the active call window

To place the voice call on hold

Sonim XP8 – Press the **menu** icon then select **Hold** Samsung S20 FE – Select the **menu** icon then select **Hold call**

If dialing into an IVR or DTMF response system select:

Sonim XP8 – Press the menu icon then select **Start DTMF** Samsung S20FE – Press the menu icon then select **Show Keypad**

Other functionality while engaged in a RTT call

Call Log and Call Detail

RTT calls are displayed in the Call Details of the Call Log/Recent Calls

- Sonim XP8:
 - Go to Recent Calls
 - Select the Recent Call
 - Select Call Details
 - Displays the text "Outgoing, Incoming RTT call"
- Samsung S20 FE:
 - Go to Recent Calls
 - Select the Recent Call
 - Select the Information icon
 - Displays the RTT icon





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Things to Know

Known Limitations

- If text is not displayed properly user may need to type at a slower speed
- Both send and receive devices must support RTT to use it.
- When adding calls while engaged in an active RTT call, calls cannot be merged, only swapped.
